The morning from 5:30 to 11:30 a.m. is a 6 hrs. telecast of original programmes which are being repeated 3 times with the gap of 6 hrs.

## **Academic Resource**

CEC has produced 600 programmes in various subject categories this year CEC already posses 9,400 enrichment programmes in 50 subject categories produced in English and Hindi language; while, nearly, 4,300 syllabus based topic have also been made available. Now the total number of programmes has gone up to 14,000. The programmes produced in the year 2004-05 have concentrated more on syllabus topics with new documentaries on topics mentioned in the bands to be blended with subject areas. These programmes are placed in Media Tape Library with the database, which includes the details of all programmes along with synopsis, their duration, year of production, place of production, etc. In the year 2004-05, CEC and Media Centres produced 600 new programmes in various subject categories including some programmes having multimedia inputs produced by EM<sup>2</sup>RC Chennai and EM<sup>2</sup>RC Calcutta.

To check the quality of the programmes produced by Media Centres and CEC, a regular Preview Committee Meetings are being organized in various subject categories in which teachers/academicians teaching in various Colleges/Universities/Institutions in Delhi, are being called to preview these programmes and on the basis of the comments made by the Preview Committee, the same is being rectified by the respective Centre before the telecast.

All the telecast capsules are being regularly quality checked before the telecast, at CEC.
